

Beef Cattle Show

Premiums will be offered in each class. In lieu of premiums, winner of the Cow/calf class will receive a trophy. Showmanship winners will receive trophies. The Showmanship Champion will compete in the Round Robin.

Beef Showmanship

1. 5 years and under
2. 6 to 10 years
3. 11 to 14 years
4. 15 to 21 years
5. Adult – any person over the age of 21 who is willing to enter the ring to be judged by the youth exhibitors

- I. Breed Classes
 - A. Junior Heifer Calf – born on January 1, 2017 or after
 - B. Late Senior Heifer Calf – born between November 1 and December 31, 2016
 - C. Early Senior Heifer Calf – born between September 1 and October 31, 2016
 - D. Late Summer Yearling Heifer – born between July 1 and August 31, 2016
 - E. Early Summer Yearling Heifer – born between May 1 and June 30, 2016
 - F. Late Junior Yearling Heifer – born between March 1 and April 30, 2016
 - G. Early Junior Yearling Heifer – born between January 1 and February 28, 2016
 - H. Late Senior Yearling Heifer – born between November 1 and December 31, 2015
 - I. Early Senior Yearling Heifer – born between September 1 and October 31, 2015
 - J. 2 Year Old Cow
 - K. 3 Year Old and older Cow

Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Beef Heifer

L. Cow/calf class – Cow of any age to be shown with her calf

- II. Steer Classes
 - M. Light Weight – estimated weight should be less than 700 pounds
 - N. Middle Weight – estimated weight should be 701 to 900 pounds
 - O. Heavy Weight – estimated weight should be more than 901 pounds

Rules for the Stars and Stripes Beef Cattle Show

1. Entries should be postmarked by June 22, 2017, accompanied by a check made out to "Stars and Stripes Livestock." Entry fees for the Show are \$5/animal. There is no charge for any showmanship or group class. There are no refunds. Animals shown in group classes must have been shown in individual classes. There will be a \$30 fee charged for each check not honored by the exhibitor's bank. The judge's decision is final. Late entries will be accepted but exhibitor's name and information will not appear in the program. Cattle do not need to be purebred.
2. Health requirements will soon be available at the N.J. Department of Agriculture website: www.nj.gov/agriculture/divisions/ah/news/fairshows.html. All out of state cattle exhibitors must have interstate health papers (CVI) dated within 30 days of this show, including:
 - a. the complete name and address of exhibitor
 - b. origin of the livestock
 - c. complete name and address of this show (Stars and Stripes Livestock Show, Burlington County Community Agricultural Center, 500 Centerton Rd. Moorestown, NJ 08057)
 - d. destination of the livestock
 - e. description of the livestock including identification numbers

All in-state cattle exhibitors must have either a CVI or AHC (**30, 60, or 90 days**).

3. Check-in is from 9:30 to 10:30 AM, Sunday June 25, 2017.
 - a. There is no limit on the number of animals that you may enter per class.
 - b. Proper conduct and treatment of animals, fellow exhibitors, show officials and the public is expected at all times.
 - c. All exhibits shall be under the direction of the Stars and Stripes Livestock Committee, and the Burlington County Community Agricultural Center, who under no circumstances will be responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by or arising from any animals or article on exhibition and the exhibitor shall indemnify the Show Committee and the management thereof, against all claims on account of or as a result from, the exhibitor's negligent handling of his/her exhibits. Any exhibitor or his representative, or his agent, who violates any of these rules and regulations of the Stars and Stripes Livestock Show at the Burlington County Community Agricultural Center will forfeit all privileges and awards and may be barred from future shows. Show entry indicates acceptance of this condition.
 - d. All animals are released after the show.
 - e. All straw, hay and trash must be removed from your area before you leave.
