*Premiums will be offered to Senior and Junior Champion and Reserve in each Breed. Showmanship class winners will receive trophies. Best showman may compete in the Round Robin at noon, showing all other species. June 25<sup>th</sup> will be the base date for determining age.*

5. Adult Showmanship – An adult is any person over the age of 21 who is willing to enter the ring to be judged by the youth.

# **Dairy Goats General Rules**

## **THE STARS AND STRIPES LIVESTOCK SHOWS**

**1.** Entries **should** be postmarked by June 22, 2017, accompanied by a check made out to “**Stars and Stripes Livestock**”. The charge is \$5/animal. There is no charge for showmanship. There are no refunds. There will be a \$30 fee charged on every check not honored by the exhibitor’s bank. Any entry not received by June 22, 2017 may not appear in the show catalogue, but may enter the show.

**2.** The judge’s decision is final.

**3.** Health requirements for in-state and out of state exhibitors will be available on:

[www.state.nj.us/agriculture/divisions/ah/news/fairsshows.html](http://www.state.nj.us/agriculture/divisions/ah/news/fairsshows.html), the NJ Department of Agriculture website.

All out of state goat exhibitors must have interstate health papers (CVI) dated within 30 days of this show, including:

- a. The complete name and address of exhibitor
- b. Origin of the livestock
- c. Complete name and address of this show (Stars and Stripes Livestock Show, Burlington County Community Agricultural Center)
- d. Destination of the livestock (Burlington County Community Agricultural Center)
- e. Description of the livestock including identification numbers

All in-state goat exhibitors must have either a CVI or an AHC (30, 60, or 90 days).

All sexually intact goats must have the approved USDA identification (eartag, microchip or tattoo). Information is available at the USDA, APHS, VS office at 609-259-5260.

**4.** The youth showman must be responsible for the care and grooming of his/her animals. All straw and hay must be removed from the arena and trailer area. Cleaning up these areas is an essential part of your exhibition. Exhibitors must provide their own water buckets, feeders and feed. Pens will be available ringside and there is plenty of room to tie up.

**5.** Exhibitors should dress appropriately - long pants and solid toed shoes or boots are required. Dairy Goat exhibitors should wear white pants and a white shirt, but jeans and a white shirt are allowed. White lab coats are also permitted. Consideration of the dress code will be given to those showing other species.

**6.** Dairy Goat check in is from 9:30 until 10:00 AM. We will be diligent in ensuring that all animals shown pose no health risk to other livestock or humans.

**7.** Proper conduct and treatment of animals, fellow exhibitors, show officials and the public is expected at all times.

**8.** All exhibits shall be under the direction of the Stars and Stripes Livestock Committee officials and Burlington County Community Agricultural Center, who under no circumstances will be responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by or arising from any animal or article on exhibition and the exhibitor shall indemnify the Show Committee and of the management thereof, against all claims on account of or result from, the exhibitors’ negligent handling of his/her exhibits. Any exhibitor or his/her representative, or his/her agent, who violates any of these rules and regulations of the Stars and Stripes Livestock Show at the Burlington County Community Agricultural Center will forfeit all privileges and may be barred from future shows. Show entrance indicates acceptance of these conditions.

**9.** Exhibitors participating in activities at the Show are responsible to the Chairman of the Show and the Stars and Stripes Livestock Committee. Exhibitors are responsible for the care of exhibits, equipment and the facilities to ensure that no damage occurs. The Show Chairman reserves the privilege of ruling on such cases.

**10.** Showmanship class winners will receive trophies. Each Champion Showman will be eligible to compete in the Round Robin Competition, showing all other species. All youth under the age of 21 on June 25, 2017 may compete in youth showmanship classes.

**11.** There will be no pre-show milk out. Over distention of the udder will be discriminated against.

**12.** Any Doe over 24 months that has never freshened will be shown in the Junior Division.

**13.** Horned goats are not allowed to show in this show.
