Poultry and Waterfowl General Rules

1. Entries **should** be postmarked by June 22, 2017, accompanied by a check made out to “Stars and Stripes Livestock” at a rate of \$4/bird. There is no charge for showmanship. There are no refunds. There will be a \$30 fee charged on every check not honored by the exhibitor’s bank.
2. The judge’s decision is final.
3. Health requirements for in-state and out of state exhibitors are available on:
www.state.nj.us/agriculture/divisions/ah/news/fairsshows.html., the NJ Department of Agriculture website.

All out of state (imported) poultry exhibitors must have either CVI or VS Form 9-2 or 9-3 and shall originate from U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid clean flock or have a negative Pullorum-Typhoid certificate dated within 90 days of the show. Birds less than 4 months of age shall originate from Pullorum-Typhoid negative flocks, but are not required to have a negative certificate since the test is not valid for them. Poultry originating from areas with confirmed cases of Avian Influenza must obtain a permit number that must appear on the CVI or VS form 9-2

or 9-3. To obtain a permit, number, contact the NJ Department of Agriculture, Division of Animal Health at: 609-292-3965.

All instate (native) poultry, small animal and rabbit exhibitors shall be accompanied by a CVI, AHC, VS Form 9-2 or 9-3 or a 4-H Poultry, Rabbit or Cavy Health Form. This form will be available at the show for you to complete. Poultry, over 4 months of age must have a negative Pulum-Typhoid certificate. Contact Robin Bruins at 609-259-2347, if you need help in securing a Pullorum-Typhoid Certificate.

4. The youth showman must be responsible for the care and grooming of his/her birds. Cleaning up these areas is an essential part of your exhibition. Show cages will be provided.

5. Exhibitors should dress appropriately - long pants are suggested and solid toed shoes or boots are required. White lab coats are also permitted.

6. Poultry and Waterfowl Coop-in is from 9:30 until 10:00 AM. We will be diligent in ensuring that all animals shown pose no health risk to other livestock or humans.

7. Proper conduct and treatment of animals, fellow exhibitors, show officials and the public is expected at all times.

8. All exhibits shall be under the direction of the Stars and Stripes Livestock Inc. Committee officials and the Burlington County Agricultural Center, who under no circumstances will be responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by or arising from any animal or article on exhibition and the exhibitor shall indemnify the Show Committee and of the management thereof, against all claims on account of or result from, the exhibitors' negligent handling of his exhibits. Any exhibitor or his representative, or his agent, who violates any of these rules and regulations of the Stars and Stripes Livestock Show at the Burlington County Agricultural Center will forfeit all privileges and may be barred from future shows. **Show entrance indicates acceptance of these conditions.**

9. Exhibitors participating in activities at the Show are responsible to the Chairman of the Show and the Stars and Stripes Livestock Committee. Exhibitors are responsible for the care of exhibits, equipment and the facilities to ensure that no damage occurs. The Show Chairman reserves the privilege of ruling on such cases.

10. Showmanship class winners will receive trophies. The Champion Showman will be eligible to compete in the Round Robin Competition. All youth under the age of 21 on June 25, 2017 may compete in youth showmanship classes.

14. American Bantam Association (ABA) and American Poultry Association (APA) standards will be used to evaluate the birds, except Division C. the Meat and Layer Birds which will be judged according to market standards.
