Photos must include the youth showing the animal in proper show attire. Photos must be taken by amateur photographers. Altered photos such as "stretching" are not allowed.
2. There are no entry fees and no awards. All entries will be judged by professional judges who will offer oral reasons via email.
3. By submitting an image, you allow Stars and Stripes Livestock, Inc. to use it on social media.

5. You may enter one animal/class. You do not have to own the animal. You do not have to be a 4-H or FFA member.

2. Since you should not use your feet to make your cow move her rear feet, what should you do to make her move her rear foot so that she is not too stretched out?
3. What is the gestation period of a dairy cow?
