Each Photo Entry must include a profile (side) view taken from a 4 foot distance and a photo taken from 3 foot above the animal. Photos must include the youth showing the animal in proper show attire. Photos must be taken by amateur photographers. Altered photos such as "stretching" are not allowed.
2. There are no entry fees and no awards. All entries will be judged by professional judges who will offer oral reasons via email.
3. By submitting an image, you agree to allow Stars and Stripes Livestock, Inc. to use it on social media.
