SHOWMANSHIP ROUND-UP

Rules:

1. Enter the appropriate age group –

2. You must answer the questions for your age group as well as the questions in all of the age groups younger than you are. ie. If you are 13 years old, you must answer the “5and under” and the “6-10 questions too.

Showmanship Round-up Questions for five and under

1. Draw a goat and label 3 parts.
2. What could happen if your goat puts his head down?
3. Is it bad for your goat when he burps?

Showmanship Round-up for 6 – 10 year olds

1. What is the normal temperature of an adult doe?
2. What is your favorite breed of goat and why?
3. Why do goats have a USDA ear tag in their ear?

Showmanship Round-up for 11 – 14 year olds

1. What do you do with your hands when you have to perform a roll turn (to turn in front of the judge), if you were walking in a clockwise direction?
2. If the judge is facing the rear of your goat and she (the judge) takes two steps to the right, what should you do?
3. If your male kid is in obvious pain, what serious problem could it be? What can you do to prevent this?

Showmanship Round-up for 15 – 21 year olds

1. Most people set up the rear legs first and then concentrate on setting the front legs. How do you know when the front legs are set correctly?
2. Draw or trace a goat's digestive system and label.
3. Angora is a breed of goat that produces long, wavy coats of fiber called _____. Cashmere is another goat fiber. Is there a Cashmere Goat breed that produces this fiber?
