DAIRY GOAT SHOW

Rules:

1. Every goat entered MUST be entered on its own email – **ONE GOAT ON ONE ENTRY FORM**. If you wish to show more than one goat, that is great, just complete more entry forms. Each youth must use his/her own entry form. Complete the entry form and email to bruinsjr@optonline.net by June 28, 2020. Each Photo Entry must include a profile (side) view and a rear view taken from a 6 foot distance. Photos must include the youth showing the animal in proper show attire. Photos must be taken by amateur photographers. Altered photos such as “stretching” are not allowed.
2. There are no entry fees and no awards. All entries will be judged by professional judges who will offer oral reasons via email.
3. By submitting an image, you agree to allow Stars and Stripes Livestock, Inc. to use it on social media.

5. You may enter one animal/class.

SHOWMANSHIP ROUND-UP

Rules:

1. Enter the appropriate age group-
 1. five years and under
 2. 6 to 10 years old
 3. 11 to 14 years old
 4. 15 to 21 years old

2. You must answer the questions for your age group as well as the questions in all of the age groups younger than you are. ie. If you are 12 years old, you must answer the “5 and under” and the “6 to 10 year old” questions too.
3. Adults may read the question to and help write the answers for those entered in classes 1 and 2, but the youth must answer the questions.

Showmanship Round-up Questions for five and Under Youth

1. What should you do at home to get your goat ready for the show ring?
2. Name one part of a dairy goat’s body.
3. Name a feed that your goat should eat.

Showmanship Round-up Questions for 6 to 10 year olds

1. What do you call a castrated male goat?
2. Choose a breed of dairy goat and describe the history and five points of the standard for that breed?
3. Describe how to care for your goat’s hooves. What tools do you need?

Showmanship Round-up Questions for 11 to 14 year olds

1. When you have to turn around with your goat in the show ring, you should stop and
 - a. turn away from your goat
 - b. turn your goat into you.
2. Which should be closer together: a. the rear legs b. the front legs
3. Draw or trace a doe’s reproductive system and label the parts?

Showmanship Round-up Questions for 15 to 21 year olds

1. What is the proper name for “setting up” your goat?
2. If the judge asks you to walk your goat in a circle, where should you be walking if the judge is inside the circle? How about if the judge is standing outside of the circle?
3. If a three year old doe has never freshened before, can she be shown in the Dry Doe class?

LIVESTOCK INNOVATIONS
