SHEEP SHOW

Rules:

1. Every sheep entered MUST be entered in its own email – **ONE SHEEP ON ONE ENTRY FORM**. If you wish to show more than one sheep, that is great, just complete more entry forms. Each youth must use his/her own entry form. Complete the entry form and email it and the photos to bruinsjr@optonline.net by June 28, 2020. Each Photo Entry must include a profile (side) view and a rear view - all taken from six feet distance. Photos must include the youth showing the animal in proper show attire. Photos must be taken by amateur photographers. Altered photos such as “stretching” are not allowed.
2. There are no entry fees and no awards. All entries will be judged by professional judges who will offer oral reasons via email.
3. By submitting an image, you agree to allow Stars and Stripes Livestock, Inc. to use it on social media.

5. You may enter one animal/class.

IV. Market Lamb Division

IV. Lambs must have been born after January 1, 2020, either ewes or wethers and shown in less than 1 inch fleece or slick shorn. Lambs will be divided into weight groups depending on appearance (light, middle or heavy) and will be judged on muscling and structure.

V. Best Fleece

V. Parting the fleece at the *Shoulder, Hip and Midway* sections, take one photo each of these three sections of the sheep/lamb's fleece. The three photos should be taken as SIDE views. Send an additional photo of a piece of the fleece parallel to a ruler to demonstrate its length and enable the judge to better evaluate the crimp.

Rules:

Showmanship Round-up Questions for Five and Under Youth

1. When you come into the ring with your sheep, who should you look at?
2. What should you do if your sheep is afraid to go into the ring?
3. Name one part of a sheep’s body.

Showmanship Round-up Questions for 6 to 10 year old Youth

1. Sometimes sheep like to run away. What can you do to prevent this?
2. When the judge comes in front of your sheep, what part of your body should you put against the breast?
3. Why should you NOT give goat, cattle or horse mineral mixes to your sheep?

Showmanship Round-up Questions for 11 to 14 year old Youth

1. When you set up your sheep, her back left leg and hoof are too far forward. What should you do?
2. The person in front of you in the ring has a lamb who stops and flops onto the ground. What should you do?
3. What is the normal temperature of an adult ewe?

Showmanship Round-up Questions for 15 to 21 year old Youth

1. What can you do to make a lamb raise her back in the show ring?
2. If your ewe is cow hocked, what could you do in the ring to make this less noticeable?
3. List the parts of a sheep digestive system and their function.
